

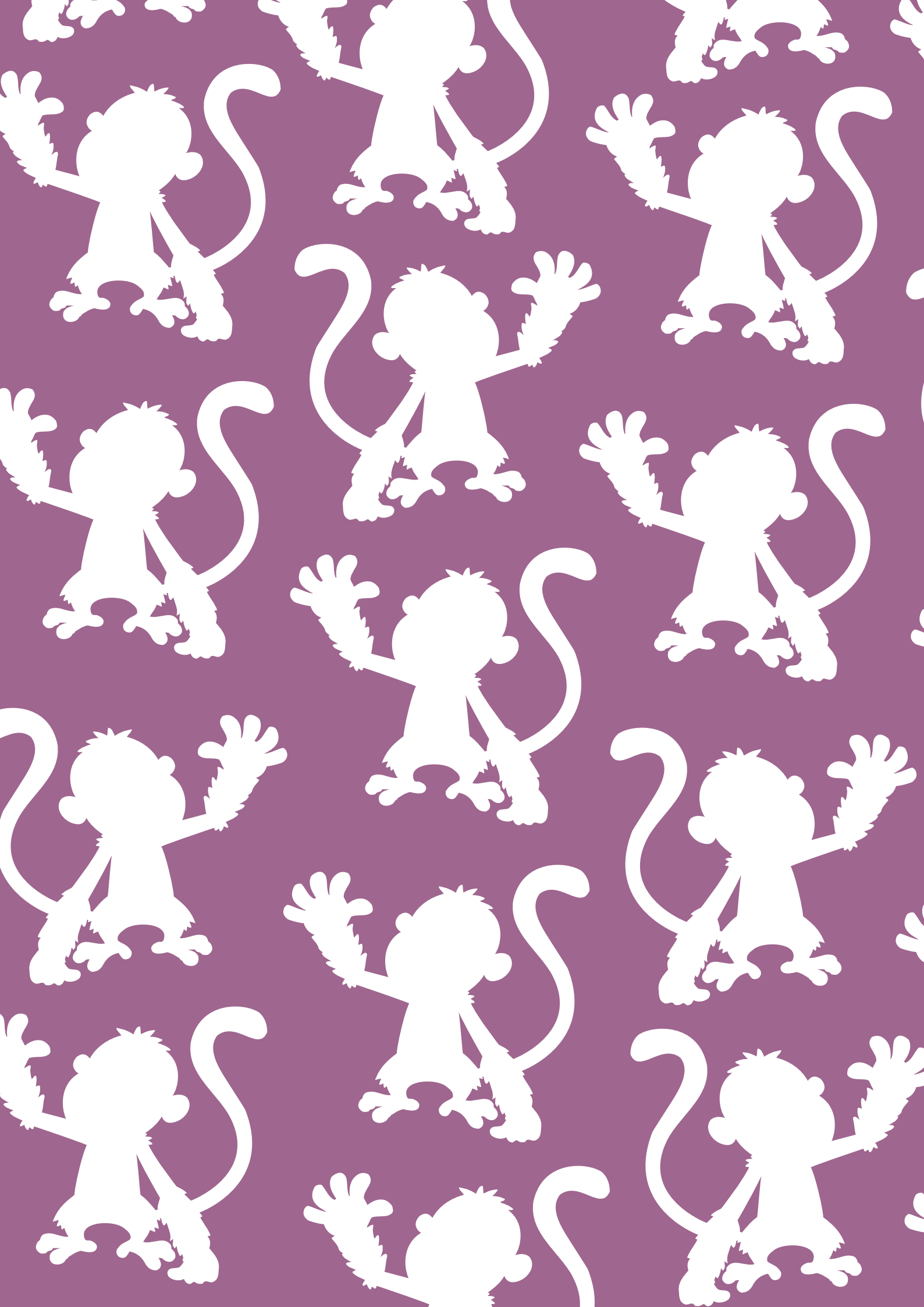

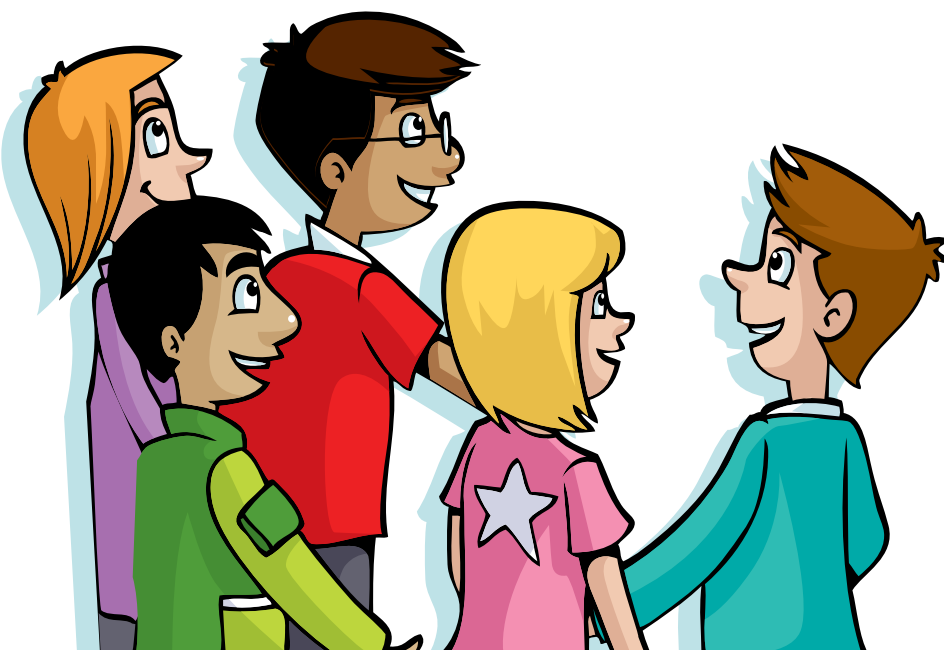

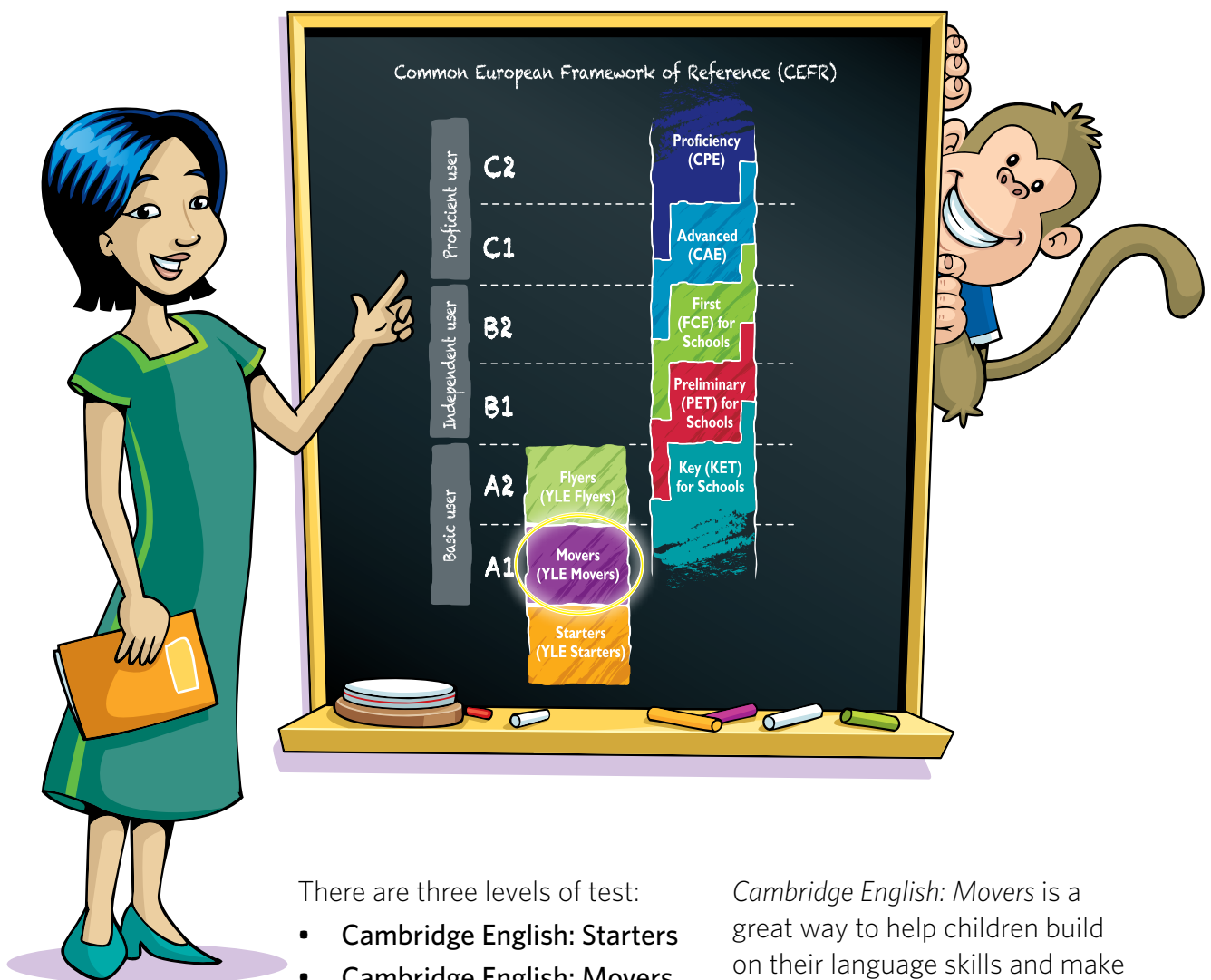






# About Cambridge English: Movers

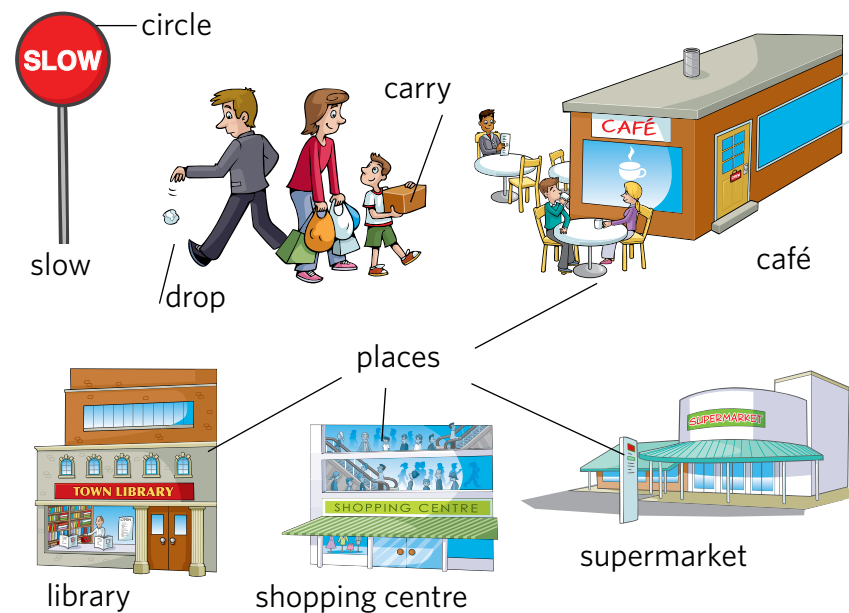




# Our town
